

BY-LAW NO. 2035

BEING A BY-LAW respecting the non-application of The Labour Relations Act to the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay deems it expedient that the provisions of The Labour Relations Act R.S.O. 1960, Chapter 202, do not apply to the City of North Bay in its dealings with its employees.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. THAT the City of North Bay, being a Municipality as defined in The Department of Municipal Affairs Act hereby declares that The Labour Relations Act does not apply to the said City of North Bay in its relations with its employees or any of them.
2. THAT all previous By-laws or provisions in previous By-laws inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law be and the same are hereby repealed.
3. THAT this By-law shall take effect upon the passing thereof.
