BEING a By-Law for numbering the buildings and lots along the Highways and for affixing numbers to the buildings in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS various petitions have been presented to the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay relative to the confusion and delays caused by the present numbering of many of the buildings in the City of North Bay.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to rearrange the numbering of the buildings in the said City.

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL ACT BEING R.S.O. 1937, CHAPTER 266, particularly SECTION 407 SS 40 and 41 AND AMENDMENTS THBRETO ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:
(1) That the houses, buildings and lots along the streets of the said City be numbered and numbers be affixed to the said houses or buildings as follows:
a. That all buildings and lots shall be numbered east and west starting from Ferguson Street which shall be considered the dividing line for such numbering.
b. That a number shall be alloted for each 15' of lot.
c. That in issuing and affixing said numbers the location of the building on the lot and entrance to said building must be considered.
d. That odd numbers shall be affixed on the southerly and westerly side of each street and even numbers on the northerly and easterly side.
e. That all numbers must be placed on the buildings in such a position as to be clearly visible from the street. (2) That the expenses incidental to the affixing of said numbers on buildings or lots under the provisions of this By-Law shall be charged to the owner or occupant of such building or lot and that such expense may be collected in the same manner as taxes provided that if paid by the occupant, subject to any agreement between him and the owner, may be deducted from the rent payable to the owner.
(3) That Assessment Commissioner of the said City of North Bay be and is hereby empowered and instructed to affix numbers as aforesaid.
(4) That the Assessment Comnissioner of the said City shall keep in
a specially prepared book to which access may be had at all reasonable
hours by the public, a record of the streets and numbers of the houses and lots numbered thereon respectively, and showing a division of the streets with boundaries and distances. (5) That By-Law No. 280 and all other By-Laws inconsistent with this By-Law be and the same are hereby repealed.
