BY-LAW NO. 2004-05

BEING A BY-LAW TO EXCLUDE A PARTICIPATING EMPLOYER (NORTH BAY-MATTAWA CONSERVATION AUTHORITY) FROM THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY'S ONTARIO MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM EMPLOYER GROUP

Whereas pursuant to subsection 15(1) of the OMERS Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter 0.29 and Regulation 890 as amended, the Corporation of the City of North Bay (the Employer) passed Bylaw Number 2066 which authorized the Employer to participate in OMERS on behalf of its employees.

And whereas since 1974 the practice has been to include employees of the North Bay-Mattawa Conservation Authority in the Corporation of the City of North Bay's OMERS employer group.

And whereas it is now desirable that the North Bay-Mattawa Conservation Authority participate in OMERS as a single Employer with effect from January 1, 2004.

Whereas Council has passed a resolution on the 12th day of January 2004 to exclude the North Bay-Mattawa Conservation Authority from OMERS;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay hereby excludes the participation of employees of the North Bay-Mattawa Conservation Authority under the Corporation of the City of North Bay's OMERS employer group effective January 1, 2004.
