

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 140-84

A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE ACQUISITION OF THE
DIONNE HOUSE.

WHEREAS the Council deems it desirable to acquire the Dionne House as a Museum pursuant to section 208 (57) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, chapter 302, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this by-law, "Dionne House" means the home formerly owned by Oliva Dionne and Elzire Dionne wherein Annette, Yvonne, Cecile, Emilie and Marie were born on May 28, 1934 in Corbeil, Ontario.
2. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized to acquire the Dionne House and all the contents and artifacts contained therein as a museum according to the terms of that certain Offer to Purchase dated September 12, 1984 attached as Schedule "A" to this by-law.
3. The consideration to be paid upon acquisition of the said Dionne House and all the contents and artifacts contained therein shall be provided by private fund raising and by a grant from the Minister of Northern Affairs of the Province of Ontario and no municipal tax monies shall be paid therefore.
4. This by-law comes into force and effect upon being passed.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 22ND DAY OF OCTOBER, 1984.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 22ND DAY OF OCTOBER, 1984.
