BY-LAW NO. 1356

BEING A BY-LAW REGULATING THE CLOSING of Stores under Classification of Service Stations (being all shops selling gasoline, oil and washing and Greasing of Motor Vehicles.

<u>AND WHEREAS</u> a petition duly signed under the provisions of Section 82, subsection 4, of the Factory, Shop and Office Building Act, being R. S. O., 1937, Chapter 194, has been presented to the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay praying that by-law be passed amending by-law 390 and all amendments thereto in as far as they effect the business classified as Service Stations.

<u>AND WHEREAS</u> it is deemed advisable to amend by-law 390 and all amendments thereto in accordance with the petition as presented. THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That all Service Stations (being all shops selling gasoline, oil and washing and Greasing Motor Vehicles) within the limits of the City of North Bay shall be closed at the hour of seven o'clock in the afternoon of each day in each week of the year and the said shops shall remain closed from the said hour of seven o'clock in the afternoon until five o'clock on the following morning.

2. That the provisions of by-law 390 and all amendments thereto inconsistent with the Provisions of this By-law are hereby repealed. THIS BY-law shall come into force and take effect on the 15th. day of August. A. D. 1941.

READ a first time in Open Council this fifth day of August, 1941. READ a second time in Open Council this fifth day of August, 1941. RULES OF ORDER were suspended and by-law read a third time short and passed this fifth day of August, 1941.
