BY-LAW NO. 1868

BEING A BY-LAW to provide for the Election of Members of Local Boards to be held at the same time as the Election for Members of Council of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of North Bay has under the provisions of the Municipal Act, by By-law No. 1867, provided that the term of Office of the Members of the Council of the Municipality shall be two years and that biennial elections be held to elect such members.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of North Bay may, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Act, by By-law, provide that every elected member of any local Board, as defined by the Department of Municipal Affairs Act, that is designated in the By-law, shall, notwithstanding any general or special Act, be elected at the same time and hold office for the same term as the members of the Council.

AND WHEREAS it appears expedient that every elected member of the Public School Board of the City of North Bay and of the North Bay Hydro Electric Commission, shall be elected at such biennial elections at the same time and hold office for the same term as the Members of Council.

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That after the final passing of this by-law, every elected member of the Public School Board of the City of North Bay and of the North Bay Hydro Electric Commission shall be elected at the same time and hold office for the same term as the Members of the Council of the City of North Bay.
- That all Elected Members of the Public School Board of North Bay and of the North Bay Hydro Electric Commission in office on the passing of this By-law, shall cease to hold office at the end of the year in which the by-law is passed.
- 3. That any provision or provisions in any by-law or by-laws inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law be and the same are hereby repealed.
- 4. That this by-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof.
