## BY-LAW NO. 2066

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to authorize participation in the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement System.

WHEREAS pursuant to section 15 of The Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement System Act, 1961-62 a municipality may by by-law or resolution elect to participate in the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement System and pay to the fund the total of the employer and employee contributions, and has all of the powers necessary and incidental thereto:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AS A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay hereby elects to participate in the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement System as of the 1st day of January, 1963 and authorizes the treasurer to submit this election in writing to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement Board.
- 2. Every person who becomes a permanent employee of the Corporation on or after the 1st day of January, 1963 shall, as a condition of his employment, become a member of the System.
- 3. The treasurer of the Corporation is hereby authorized to deduct and to remit the employer and the employee contributions as required, to execute all necessary documents and to do such things as are necessary to carry out the intent of this by-law.
- The treasurer shall file a certificate with the Secretary-Treasurer of the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement Board to the effect that employees who are policemen are entitled to retire at age 65 years and firemen are entitled to retire at age 65 years.
- 5. The Corporation hereby elects to participate together with the following local boards of the Corporation as a single employer.

under The Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement System Act, 1961-62 and the Regulation thereunder.

6. That By-law No. 1410 and By-law No. 1425, and all other by-laws inconsistent with this by-law be and the same are hereby repealed.
