WHEREAS Section 46.(3) of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996 provides that a municipal council may pass a by-law with respect to reduced voting hours in voting places in retirement homes or those institutions as defined in Section 45.(7) of the said Act, where the voting place is only for the use of residents;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Those voting places as shown in Schedule "A" attached hereto, shall be open for those hours as also detailed in Schedule "A".

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 25TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2000.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 25TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2000.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 25TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2000.
