

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 221-90

A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF O.N.R.
TRAIN WHISTLES AT LEVEL CROSSINGS IN THE
CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS Section 210 (132) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, c. 302, authorizes the council to pass by-laws for regulating or prohibiting the blowing of horns or noises likely to disturb the inhabitants;

AND WHEREAS Section 155 of the Railway Act of Ontario, relieves the Ontario Northland Transportation Commission of the obligation to sound a railway train engine whistle when a train is approaching a highway crossing where a municipal by-law is in force prohibiting the sounding of the whistle;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to prohibit the sounding of any railway train engine whistle where the Ontario Northland Railway crosses Lees Road, Highway 11 North and Franklin Street in the City of North Bay between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sounding of any railway train engine whistle at the following highway crossings in the City of North Bay is hereby prohibited between the hours of 8:00 p.m. of one day to 8:00 a.m. of the next day:

2. This by-law shall come into force upon being passed.
3. By-law No. 76-88 is hereby repealed.
