THIS İ SCHEDULE "A" TO BY-LAW NO. 76-71 OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

All and singular the lands and premises situate, lying and being in the City of North Bay in the District of Nipissing and being composed of that portion of a laneway shown on Plan 57 registered in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the District of Nipissing which said land is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the south west angle of Lot 72 according to said plan;

Thence southerly a distance of fourteen feet (14') more or less to the north west angle of Lot 71;

Thence easterly along the north boundary of Lot 71, a distance of one-hundred and thirty-two feet (132') to the north east angle of said lot; Thence northerly a distance of fourteen feet (14') to the south east angle of Lot 73 ;

Thence westerly along the southerly boundaries of Lots 73 and 72, a distance of one-hundred and thirty-two feet (132') to the point of commencement.
