BY-LAW NUMBER 935

BEING a By-Law to authorize the construction of a sanitary sewer on Cassell Street or Trout Lake Road in the City of North Bay.

UNDER and by virtue of a Mandatory Order issued by the Provincial Department of Health and dated the 17th day of June, A. D. 1929, under the provisions of the Public Health Act, R. S. O. 1927, Chater 262, Section 97, and approval thereof dated the 17th day of June, A. D. 1929, and

UNDER and by virtue of an Agreement entered into between the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay and the Department of Public Works of the Province of Ontario.

THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT a 12 inch sanitary sewer be constructed on Cassell Street or Trout Lake Road from Station 3 29, which station is opposite the Home of the Aged, to Station 38 65, which is the limits of the City of North Bay; and a 10 inch sanitary sewer communication with the portion referred to, to the property line of the site of the Provincial gaol being of a length of 35 feet more or less.
- THAT the Engineer of the Corporation do forthwith make such plans, profiles and specifications and furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.
- THAT the work shall be carried on and executed undet the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of such Engineer.
- THAT the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to cause a contract for the construction of the work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of this Council to be declared by resolution.
- THE Treasurer may, subject to the approval of the Council, agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending the completion of it.
- 6. THE cost of construction shall be borne by the Provincial Department of Public Works and the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay in the proportion of 5/7 and 2/7 respectively, as agreed upon in and Agreement between the Provincial Department of Public Works and the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay, dated the 7th day of September, A. D. 1929.
- THE cost of the construction of the Corporation's share shall be paid in twenty annual instalments out of the general rate.
- THE debenture to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the Corporation's share of the cost of the work, when completed, shall bear interest at 5% per annum and be made payable within twenty years on the instalment plan.
- THAT the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay may at any time, hereafter to be decided upon by a resolution to that effect, proceed to levy against and assess the lands abutting on and adjacent to the sewer constructed under the authority hereof, for the right of connection to and their use of the said sewer within the Municipal Corpornection. ation of the City of North Bay.
