

BY-LAW NUMBER 935

BEING a By-Law to authorize the construction of a sanitary sewer on Cassell Street or Trout Lake Road in the City of North Bay.

UNDER and by virtue of a Mandatory Order issued by the Provincial Department of Health and dated the 17th day of June, A. D. 1929, under the provisions of the Public Health Act, R. S. O. 1927, Chapter 262, Section 97, and approval thereof dated the 17th day of June, A. D. 1929, and

UNDER and by virtue of an Agreement entered into between the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay and the Department of Public Works of the Province of Ontario.

THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT a 12 inch sanitary sewer be constructed on Cassell Street or Trout Lake Road from Station 3 29, which station is opposite the Home of the Aged, to Station 38 65, which is the limits of the City of North Bay; and a 10 inch sanitary sewer communication with the portion referred to, to the property line of the site of the Provincial gaol being of a length of 35 feet more or less.

2. THAT the Engineer of the Corporation do forthwith make such plans, profiles and specifications and furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.

3. THAT the work shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of such Engineer.

4. THAT the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to cause a contract for the construction of the work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of this Council to be declared by resolution.

5. THE Treasurer may, subject to the approval of the Council, agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending the completion of it.

6. THE cost of construction shall be borne by the Provincial Department of Public Works and the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay in the proportion of 5/7 and 2/7 respectively, as agreed upon in and Agreement between the Provincial Department of Public Works and the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay, dated the 7th day of September, A. D. 1929.

7. THE cost of the construction of the Corporation's share shall be paid in twenty annual instalments out of the general rate.

8. THE debenture to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the Corporation's share of the cost of the work, when completed, shall bear interest at 5% per annum and be made payable within twenty years on the instalment plan.

9. THAT the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay may at any time, hereafter to be decided upon by a resolution to that effect, proceed to levy against and assess the lands abutting on and adjacent to the sewer constructed under the authority hereof, for the right of connection to and their use of the said sewer within the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay.

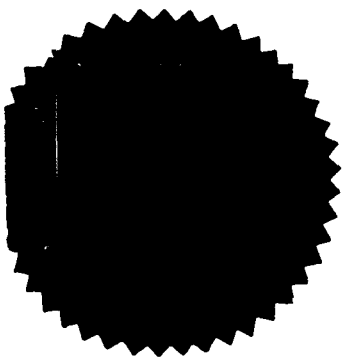
It is hereby certified that the Department, having inquired into, ascertained and considered the existing sanitary conditions of the municipality of the \_\_\_\_\_ CITY OF NORTH BAY\_\_\_\_\_

is of the opinion that it is necessary in the interests of the public health that a sewer be constructed on Cassels Street from Olive Street to the New District Jail, at a total estimated cost of Eight Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty-four Dollars and Twenty-three Cents (\$8,854.23), with the proviso that: (1) The lands adjacent to said sewer and outside the municipality of North Bay shall not be subject to assessment for either installation, or maintenance of sewer.

(2) Persons owning property abutting on the line of the sewer and outside the municipality of North Bay shall have the right of connection to said sewer at a price to be agreed upon, or to be determined by arbitration; the arbitrators to be one representative of the applicant for sewer connection; one representative of the City of North Bay, and one representative to be appointed by the Ontario Department of Health,

in the above municipality, and accordingly issues the above as a mandatory order under the authority of Sec. 98 of the Public Health Act, 1927, R.S.O. 1914., Chap. 218.
