THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY BY-LAW NO. 134-89

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE A PORTION OF MEMORIAL DRIVE, QUEEN STREET AND JAMES STREET.

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the North Bay Legion Track Club, it is deemed expedient to temporarily close a portion of Memorial Drive, Queen Street and James Street pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Sec. 208, Subsection 44.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the portion of Memorial Drive from James Street to a point 0.2 km east of the Government Dock, Queen Street from James Street to Memorial Drive and James Street from Queen Street to Memorial Drive in the City of North Bay be and the same are hereby closed from 9:15 o'clock in the forenoon until 10:45 o'clock in the forenoon on Sunday, the 6th day of August, 1989, and Sunday, the 8th day of October, 1989, for the purpose of a road race.
- That the City Engineer is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.
- of August, 1989, and the 8th day of October, 1989, the North Bay Legion Track Club will attend to the restoration of the said portions of Memorial Drive, Queen Street and James Street, to their condition prior to the above closures.
