  - Risk Management
  - Communication and Technology

- o Trying to get the organization to go in the same direction.
- o Chamber of Commerce is working with Invest North Bay
- o The City has reduced 28 full time positions 25 through attrition
- o The City has saved thousands of dollars by leasing equipment
- o Need to promote and advance the community
- o The 2012 priorities are evolving continuously
- Council gives direction re: priorities and staff must set these priorities within their business unit.
- Invest North Bay will be focusing on bringing new business to the community. Council and senior staff have a role to play in business retention and expansion.
- Focus needs to be kept on the priorities if there are good reasons to change the priorities that is okay.
