

BY-LAW NO. 2308

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to provide for the construction of a storm sewer system on certain streets in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of Section 379(1) (52) of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1960, the Council may pass by-laws subject to the approval of The Ontario Municipal Board, for the construction of sewage works;

AND WHEREAS it is intended that the cost of the construction of the works included herein shall be borne by the Corporation at large;

AND WHEREAS the works are in the public interest;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT a storm sewer system as described in Schedule "A" annexed hereto and forming part of this by-law be designed and constructed.
2. THAT the total gross cost of the said works is estimated at \$58,300.00 against which there will be a Highway's Subsidy estimated at \$19,400.00, leaving a balance of \$38,900.00 which shall be levied against the Corporation of the City of North Bay.
3. THE said Corporation is hereby authorized to issue debentures for all or any portion of the capital cost of the works referred to herein, payable in fifteen (15) annual instalments of principal and interest at such rate as Council may determine.
4. THE Head of the Council and the Treasurer may, subject to the approval of Council, agree with any bank or persons for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the works pending completion thereof.

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

A Storm Sewer System with the necessary mains, manholes and other appurtenances to provide drainage facilities on the streets as follows:

1. Fourth Avenue from Fisher Street to Sherbrooke Street and on Sherbrooke Street easterly 157 lineal feet.
2. Victoria Street from Ferguson Street to Wyld Street.
3. High Street from drainage course westerly to lane west of Bank Street and northerly on lane 150 lineal feet.
4. Pinewood Crescent westerly through easement on Lot #112 Plan 114, 410 lineal feet to drainage course in Block "A".
5. Glenwood Road southwesterly through easement in Block "K" 520 lineal feet to drainage course in Block "A".
6. McIntyre Street through easement on Lot 49, Plan 116, 160 lineal feet to a drainage course.
7. Aubrey Street from Cassells Street to High Street.
8. Amelia Street from Charles Street northwesterly 350 lineal feet.
9. (i) Burns Street from Jane Street to Elizabeth Street.
(ii) Elizabeth Street from Burns Street to Lot 73.
(iii) Scollard Street from Burns Street easterly to lane 220 lineal feet.
10. Bloem Street from Beattie Street westerly 100 lineal feet to Lot 600.

Total estimated cost including engineering
and contingencies \$58,300.00

UPON THE APPLICATION OF The Corporation of the
City of North Bay for approval of the construction
of the storm sewers described in Schedule "A" attached
hereto at an estimated cost of \$58,300 and the borrow-
ing of the sum of \$38,900 therefor, and upon reading
the material filed;

THE BOARD ORDERS, under and in pursuance of the
legislation hereinbefore referred to, and of any and
all other powers vested in the Board, that the said
application be and the same is hereby granted, and
that The Corporation may now proceed with the said
undertaking and for such purpose may pass a by-law
authorizing the said undertaking and all other requisite
by-laws, including by-laws providing for the issue of
debentures in a principal amount not exceeding \$38,900
repayable over a term of not more than fifteen years, and
may borrow money to the extent sufficient to provide
an amount not exceeding \$38,900 therefor, provided:

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1. that any by-law authorizing the said undertaking is passed by a three-fourths vote of all members of the Council of the said corporation, and
2. that the said corporation may borrow the whole or any part of the said sum of \$58,300 as required pending receipt of subsidies and the sale of debentures, or of moneys to be received from any other source, and
3. that the amount to be debentured shall not exceed in any event the net cost to the Corporation after deducting any grant or contribution from the Province of Ontario or from any other source in respect of the said work, and
4. that the Corporation in exercising any of its powers approved by this order shall comply with all statutory and other legal requirements related thereto.

5. GLENWOOD ROAD south westerly through easement in Block "K" 520 lineal feet to drainage course in Block "A"
6. McINTYRE STREET through easement on Lot 49, Plan 116, 160 lineal feet to a drainage course
7. AUBREY STREET from Cassells Street to High Street
8. AMELIA STREET from Charles Street north westerly 350 lineal feet
9. (i) BURNS STREET from Jane Street to Elizabeth Street
(ii) ELIZABETH STREET from Burns Street to Lot 73
(iii) SCOLLARD STREET from Burns Street easterly to lane 220 lineal feet
10. BLOEM STREET from Beattie Street westerly 100 lineal feet to Lot 600
