

BY-LAW NUMBER 889.

BEING A BY-LAW to appoint a Bread Inspector and to provide for the licensing of Bakeshops and the regulating of the sale of bread according to the provisions of the Bread Sales Act, R.S.O. 1927, Chapter 268.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient:

- (a) To appoint an Inspector of Bakeshops in and for the City of North Bay.
- (b) To issue licenses to such Bakeshops.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. An Inspector shall be appointed for the City of North Bay for the purpose of inspecting and weighing any bread offered for sale, and seeing that the provisions of the Bread Sales Act, R. S. O. 1927, Chapter 268, are complied with as provided for by the Act.

2. Alfred Tandy, of the City of North Bay is hereby appointed Inspector in and for the City of North Bay for the year 1928. The salary payable to the Inspector shall be \$20.00 payable annually.

3. Licenses for bread and Bakeshops may be issued upon the production of a certificate from the Medical Officer of Health that all of the regulations and conditions have been complied with as provided for by the Bread Sales Act, R. S. O. 1927, Chapter 268.

The fee for such license shall be \$1.00.

This By-law shall take effect on the day of the passing thereof.
