## BY-LAW NO. 1526

BETNG a by-law to amend by-law no. 525 and amendments thereto.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend by-law no. 525, being a

By-Law to provide for the management and regulation of the Water

Works of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

"PROVIDED, however, that should any Industry require a larger service than one inch in diameter and in the opinion of Council it is necessary for proper Industrial Development, the Municipality of the City of North Bay will pay FORTY PER CENT (40%) of the Cost of such service and the applicant SIXTY PER CENT (60%)", so that Clause 6 will now read as follows;

## (6) SPECIAL SERVICE:

ANY person making application for the laying of service pipe greater than one inch in diameter shall at the time of such application deposit with the Corporation a sum of money estimated to be the additional cost of providing such service and subject to paragraph no. 5, upon receipt of such sum the Corporation shall provide such service pipe. PROVIDED, however, that should any Industry require a larger service than one inch in diameter and in the opinion of Council it is necessary for proper Industrial Development, the Municipality of the City of North Bay will pay FORTY PER CENT (40%) of the cost of such service and the applicant SIXTY PER CENT (60%).
