

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 85-84

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 144-77
BEING A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE AN IMPROVEMENT
AREA AND TO ESTABLISH A BOARD OF MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Section 217(17) Provides that the Council of a municipality may pass a by-law to specify a maximum charge to be levied upon persons in an improvement area;

AND WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law has been published at least once a week for four successive weeks as prescribed by the said Act;

AND WHEREAS any person liable to a special charge in the improvement area may object to the proposed by-law by filing written notice of the objection with the City Clerk before the expiry of the period of fourteen days following the day on which the notice was last published.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. Section 19 of By-law 144-77 is hereby amended by designating section "19" as "19 (a)" and by adding thereto the following paragraph:


(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a) of this section, no person shall be liable to pay a special charge levied by the Board of Management in one calendar year of more than \$2,500.00, from January 1, 1984 to December 31, 1985.
2. That this by-law comes into force as of January 1, 1984.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 9TH DAY OF JULY 1984.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 24TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER 1984.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 24TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER 1984.
