BY-LAW NO. 2080

BEING A BY-LAW of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay to provide that the term of office of members of the Council of the City of North Bay shall be two years.

AND WHEREAS the qualified electors have favourably indicated their approval of such a term of two years.

NOW WHEREAS by authority of Sec. 53(1), 53(2)(a), and Sec. 53(3) of Chapter 249 R.S.O. 1960, and Council of the Municipal Corporation of the City of North Bay enacts as follows:-

- 1. THAT after the final passing of this by-law the term of office of members of the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay shall be two years.
- 2. THAT after the final passing of this by-law biennial elections be held and, accordingly, an election shall be held every two years for the election of all the members of the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay.
- 3. THAT all the members of Council, elected at the election next after the passing of this by-law and thereafter shall hold office for a two year term.
- 4. THAT any provision or provisions in any by-law or by-laws inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law be and the same are hereby repealed.
- 5. THAT this by-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof.
