## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY BY-LAW NO. 102-94

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT DATED 29 AUGUST 1994 BETWEEN THE GOVERNING COUNCIL OF THE SALVATION ARMY IN CANADA ON BEHALF OF THE SERVICE PROVIDER, BEING THE SALVATION ARMY NORTH BAY CORPS (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE "SALVATION ARMY") AND THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY RELATING TO THE PIPER BOARDING HOUSE AT 635 MCINTYRE STREET EAST (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE "BOARDINGHOUSE") AND OTHER LOCAL ESTABLISHMENTS FOR A FEE.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That The Corporation of the City of North Bay do enter into that certain agreement dated the 29th day of August 1994 between The Governing Council of the Salvation Army in Canada on behalf of the service provider, being The Salvation Army North Bay Corps (Hereinafter referred to as the "Salvation Army") and The Corporation of the City of North Bay relating to the Piper Boarding House at 635 McIntyre Street East (hereinafter referred to as the "boardinghouse") and other local establishments for a fee.
- 2. That the Mayor and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to execute the aforesaid agreement dated the 29th day of August 1994 on behalf of The Corporation of the City of North Bay and to affix thereto the corporate seal.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 29TH DAY OF AUGUST 1994.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND PASSED THIS 29TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1994.
