BY-LAW NO. 2001-18

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 173-88 BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE PARKING ON MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS (PARKING MACHINES)

WHEREAS Section 207(56) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter, M-45, provides that by-laws may be passed for regulating, supervising and governing the parking of vehicles on land owned or occupied by the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the amendment to By-Law No. 173-88 was approved by Resolution No. 2001-102 passed on February 19,2001;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Clause No. 1 (Definitions) of By-law No. 173-88 be amended by adding the following definition to the by-law:
 - (g) "Parking Machine" means an automatic or other electronic, electromechanical or mechanical device, with the necessary standard for the device, for the purpose of controlling and regulating the parking of any vehicle in a parking space and which, when a coin, bank note or credit card has been inserted into the parking machine and the machine activated, issues a receipt indicating the date and time of that activating and the duration of the parking in or on the parking space permitted.
- 2. That the definition of "parking meter" referred to in Clause No. 1 (f) of Bylaw No. 173-88 be amended to include the words … or parking machine" as defined in Clause No. 1 of this by-law.
