

BY-LAW NO. 2001

BEING A BY-LAW for authorizing the completion of a Public Utility undertaking namely water and sewage works and service road to Keiller Mackay Park.

WHEREAS North Bay Branch 23 of the Royal Canadian Legion has undertaken a building project to provide housing for elderly citizens in the City of North Bay and such project requires water and sewage works and a service road to be brought to such project.

AND WHEREAS by Resolution passed by a three-fourths vote of all of its members, this Council deems it expedient and in the public interest to provide such water and sewage works and service road.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT a sanitary sewer, water main and service road be constructed on Olive Street as hereinafter described at a cost not to exceed \$15,000.00.
 - (i) an 8" sanitary sewer from Cassells Street Southerly a distance of 367 lineal feet.
 - (ii) a 6" watermain to interconnect existing watermains on Cassells Street and Fraser Street.
 - (iii) a service road from Cassells Street southerly to a point adjacent to the site of the Elderly Citizens Housing Project of North Bay Branch 23 Royal Canadian Legion.
2. THAT said works shall be undertaken as a Public Utility undertaking under authority of the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1960, Chap. 249, Sec. 379(1)52.
3. THAT the Engineering Department of the City of North Bay be instructed to make all necessary plans, profiles and specifications forthwith, and to furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of a contract for the execution of the work, or for the carrying on of the work by day labour.
4. THAT the work shall be carried on under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of the Engineering Department of the City of North Bay.
5. THAT the Council may decide by resolution to carry on and execute the work by day labour.
6. THAT in the absence of a resolution by Council that the work be carried on and executed by day labour, the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with some person or persons, firm or Corporation for the construction of the work, subject to the approval of the Council by resolution.
7. THAT the Treasurer may, subject to approval of the Council, agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending completion of such work.

8. THAT debentures to be issued when the work is completed to pay for the cost of such work, shall bear interest at such rate as the Council may determine, and shall be made payable within three years on the instalment plan.
9. THAT this by-law shall not become effective until approval in writing has been secured from the Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to Section 64 of the Ontario Municipal Board Act, (R.S.O. 1960).

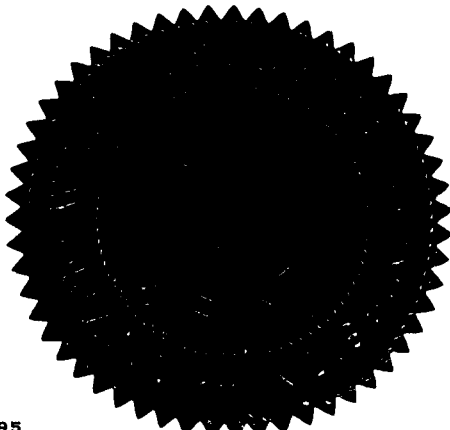

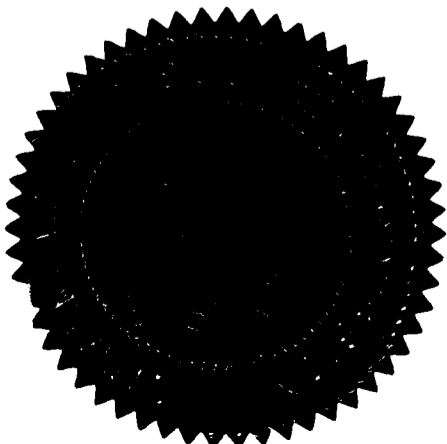
