## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

## BY-LAW NO. 101-75

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY TO CLOSE PARTS OF CERTAIN HIGHWAYS IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY TO VEHI-CULAR TRAFFIC ONLY AND TO CLOSE AND STOP UP PARTS OF CERTAIN HIGHWAYS.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of North Bay has deemed it necessary and expedient to close to vehicular traffic only certain parts of Delaware Avenue and Highland Road, located in the City of North Bay.

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the City of North Bay has deemed it necessary and expedient to stop up certain parts of Oakwood Avenue, Clarence Avenue, and Vincent Avenue located in the City of North Bay.

AND WHEREAS the closing to vehicular traffic only of parts of Delaware Avenue and Highland Road and the stopping up of parts of Oakwood, Clarence and Vincent Avenues does not deprive any person of the means of ingress and egress to and from his land or place of residence.

AND WHEREAS Notice of this proposed By-law was published for four successive weeks and the Council or a Committee of Council has heard in person any person or their representative who claims to be prejudicially affected in accordance with Section 446 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) All those parts of Delaware Avenue and Highland Road situate in the City of North Bay as shown on a Plan signed by J. R. White, O.L.S., dated June 3, 1975 and filed in the Office of Land Titles at North Bay, District of Nipissing, as Plan 36R-3780 and designated thereon as Parts 1 and 2 are to be closed to vehicular traffic only.
- (2) All those parts of Oakwood Avenue, Clarence Avenue and Vincent Avenue situate in the City of North Bay as shown on a Plan signed by J.R. White, O.L.S., dated June 3, 1975 and filed in the Office of Land Titles at North Bay, District of Nipissing, as Plan 36R-3780 and designated thereon as Parts 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 are to be stopped up.
- (3) That the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay shall be empowered to erect barricades to enforce the due observance of the within by-law.
