

BY-LAW NO. 1781

BEING A BY-LAW of the City of North Bay to give title to an administrative body with power to administer.

WHEREAS the New Community Memorial Building has been authorized by the Electors of the City of North Bay qualified to vote on Money By-laws;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed essential that such Municipal Project should be administered by a Commission;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the name of this Commission shall be, "The Community Memorial Building Commission".
2. That this Commission shall be composed of Three (3) Commissioners, who are resident Taxpayers; one to be appointed annually for a three year term, at the first meeting of the New Council.
3. That Two (2) Members of City Council shall be appointed at the first Meeting of the new Council to the Community Memorial Building Commission, who will act as Liaison Officers between City Council and the Commission.
4. That the Arena Manager shall be the Secretary of the Community Memorial Building Commission.
5. That the Commission shall have full power to manage and control the operation of the Community Memorial Building and Memorial Stadium and be responsible for the maintenance and operation of the Community Memorial Building and Memorial Stadium.
6. That for the purpose of initiation of this By-law, the Commissioners and Council Members presently in office of the Athletic Parks Commission, shall be the Commissioners and Council Members of the New Community Memorial Building Commission until their term of office has expired, or until replaced or reappointed by City Council.
7. That all By-laws inconsistent with this By-law are hereby repealed.
8. That this By-law shall come into full force and effect on the date of final passing thereof.
