BY-LAW NO. 2001-152

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 135-92,
AS AMENDED, BEING A BY-LAW FOR ESTABLISHING
AND MAINTAINING A SYSTEM FOR THE COLLECTION,
REMOVAL AND APPROPRIATE DISPOSAL OF SOLID
WASTES AND RECYCLABLE MATERIALS WITHIN
THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

WHEREAS the City of North Bay is authorized to enact by-laws for establishing and maintaining a system for the collection, removal and disposal of garbage and other refuse pursuant to Section 208.2 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M-45;

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it desirable to amend Schedule "A" to By-law No. 135-92 setting Tipping Fees for the landfill;

AND WHEREAS Council approved the establishment of a new tipping fee rate for contaminated soil at its meeting held November 5, 2001, Resolution No. 2001-701;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. That Schedule "A" to By-law No. 135-92, as amended, is hereby deleted from the by-law and the attached Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law be inserted in lieu thereof.
2. That this by-law shall come into force and effect upon passing thereof.

THIS IS SCHEDULE 'A' TO BY-LAW NO. 2001-152 OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

TIPPING FEES

- 1) The City of North Bay shall charge on a per metric tonne basis or flat fee basis the following rates for waste or other materials disposed of at the Merrick Landfill site (Tonne – Metric).
- 2) Where wastes/materials may be classified into more than one of the following categories the waste/material shall be deemed to fall within that category with the higher applicable tipping fee.

a)	Solid waste not otherwise referred to herein	\$39.00/tonne (\$20.00 load minimum)
b)	Solid waste from industrial, commercial and institutional sources	\$39.00/tonne (\$20.00 load minimum)
c)	Solid waste from municipal collection	nil
d)	Sludge from the North Bay Sewage Treatment Plant	nil
e)	Clean fill free of contaminants	nil
f)	Contaminated fill in compliance with ON. Reg. 558	\$20.00/tonne
g)	Organics free of contaminants and not requiring processing (chipped wood, grass and leaves)	nil
h)	All private vehicles, solid waste in small quantities (equivalent to 6 bags or less)	\$5.00/load
i)	All private vehicles with quantities exceeding 6 bags	\$20.00/load
j)	Appliances containing refrigerant substances (any untagged appliance)	\$25.00 each
k)	Processed biomedical waste	\$100.00 + applicable tipping fee
l)	Whole tires free of rims (per tire price)	
	i) tires with a rim diameter of 16 inches or less	\$2.00 each + vehicle fee
	ii) tires with a rim diameter greater than 16 inches	\$5.00 each + vehicle fee
	iii) tires with a rim diameter of 22 inches or greater	\$156.00/tonne (4 x tipping fee) \$20.00/load minimum)
	iv) tires with a rim diameter of 22 inches or greater split and cut into quarters	\$78.00/tonne (2 x tipping fee) \$20.00/load minimum)
m)	Annual pass for non-resident private vehicles	\$50.00 per year

n)	All commercial vehicles	Charged on a per weight basis @ applicable tipping fee
o)	All private vehicles	Charged on a flat fee basis
p)	Vehicles with a valid window sticker	nil

- 3) The above fees shall be payable prior to depositing any solid waste at the landfill site or in accordance with the accounting system established pursuant to Section 8(3)(b).

- 4) Where any waste originating from an unauthorized area outside of the City of North Bay or the Township of North Himsworth is accepted, the minimum fee shall be \$20.00/day (N.B. – no small quantity exceptions)
