## BY-LAW NUMBER 781.

Ŋ,

BEING A BY-LAW providing for the keeping, storing and transporting gasoline within the Corporation of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay deem it advisable to pass a By-law for keeping, storing and transporting of gasoline within the Corporation of the City of North Bay.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS :-

(1) THAT no person shall be permitted to erect or keep any gasoline tank or pipes connected therewith on any of the streets of the City of North Bay without first obtaining permissions from the City Council and paying the prescribed fees for the use of the space occupied by the said tank or pipes connected therewith as hereinafter set forth.

(2) THAT the fee for the tank and pipes connected therewith on any paved streets shall be Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars per year.

(3) THAT the fee for the tank and pipes connected therewith situated on unpaved streets shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per year, and the fee for tank and pipes situated on private properties shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) per year.

(4) THAT the said fee will be paid annually on the first day of January in each and every year, provided always that, where the above permission is granted during the year the license for the unexpired portion of the Calender year shall be at the rate of Two Dollars and Ten Cents (\$2.10) per month or portion thereof for paved streets and One Dollar and Twenty-Five Cents (\$1.25) per month or portion thereof for unpaved streets.

(5) THAT any person securing the right to construct a tank and pipes shall hold such right only at the will and pleasure of the Municipality and shall move the same off the highways or streets of the Municipality, or such other place as the Council shall direct on receiving one week's notice and shall be entitled to a refund for any portion of the year for which said tank or pipes have not been used but shall have no other claim against the said Municipality.

(6) THAT before any such tank shall be installed within the corporation of the City of North Bay application therefore must be made to the City Engineer, who shall report to Council before granting any permit, and no permit shall be granted without first obtaining the consent of the Council and no Tank shall be installed except at the place designated by the City Engineer, and if such tank is to be installed on private property the approval must first be obtained of the City Engineer and the Chief of the Fire Department of the City of North Bay.

(7) THAT any person convicted of a breach of the provisions of this By-law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting magistrate a penalty not exceeding the sum of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for each offence, exclusive of costs, a and in default of payment of the said penalty and costs forthwith, the said penalty and costs or costs only may be levied by distress and the sale of the goods and chattels of the offender, and in case of there being no distress found out of which said penalty can be recovered the convicting magistrate may commit the offender to the common goal in the City of North Bay, with or without hard labour for any period not exceeding six months unless the said penalty and costs be sconer paid. w 101

(8) By-Law Number Six Hundred and Twenty-six (626) is hereby repealed.
