

BY-LAW NO. 2034

BEING A BY-LAW regulating the closing of shops belonging to the class of Retail Food Shops.

WHEREAS a petition, duly signed under provisions of Section 78 of the Factory Shop and Office Buildings Act, being Chapter 130 of the Revised Statutes of Ontario 1960, has been presented to the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay praying that a by-law be passed requiring the closing of Retail Food Shops situate in the said City of North Bay during certain times and hours.


NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT all shops within the limits of the Corporation of the City of North Bay belonging to the class of Retail Food Shops shall be closed all day on each and every Monday of the year saving and excepting only the last two Mondays in December of each year and each Monday during the months of July and August other than Statutory Holidays, on which said Mondays so excepted, the said shops shall be closed at the hour of six of the clock on the afternoon of each such Monday and remain closed until five of the clock in the forenoon of the next following day.
2. THAT all of the said shops shall be closed and remain closed during the hours between six o'clock in the afternoon of each and every Tuesday and five o'clock in the forenoon of each and every Wednesday; between six o'clock in the afternoon of each and every Wednesday and five o'clock in the forenoon of each and every Thursday; between six o'clock in the afternoon of each and every Thursday and five o'clock in the forenoon of each and every Friday, excepting only when the following day Friday is a statutory holiday, in which case such closing hours shall be from nine o'clock in the afternoon of the Thursday preceding such Friday Holiday until twelve o'clock of the same afternoon; between nine o'clock in the afternoon of each and every Friday and five o'clock in the forenoon of each and every Saturday; and between six o'clock in the afternoon of each and every Saturday and twelve o'clock of the same afternoon.
3. THAT all of the said shops shall close and remain closed during the whole of every day designated as a statutory holiday.
4. THAT every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law, upon conviction thereof, shall forfeit and pay a penalty of \$100.00 for the first offence and \$300.00 for each succeeding offence.
5. THAT all previous by-laws or provisions in previous by-laws inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law be and the same are hereby repealed.
6. THAT this By-law shall take effect from the 15th day of May A.D. 1962.
