

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO.78 -79

BEING A BY-LAW TO CLOSE TEMPORARILY A PORTION  
OF MC KEOWN AVENUE, SIXTH AVENUE AND KING STREET.

WHEREAS this Council has authorized reconstruction  
of the streets herein described;

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284,  
Sec. 352, Par. 60 provides for the temporary closing of any  
highway or portion thereof.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF  
NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. (a) McKeown Avenue shall be closed between Gormanville Road  
and Cartier Street during the hours of 12:01 a.m.,  
11 June, 1979 to 11:59 p.m., 31 October, 1979.
- (b) Sixth Avenue shall be closed between Fraser Street and  
Cassells Street during the hours of 12:01 a.m.,  
11 June, 1979 to 11:59 p.m., 31 October, 1979.
- (c) King Street shall be closed between Ferguson Street and  
Fraser Street during the hours of 12:01 a.m.,  
11 June, 1979 to 11:59 p.m., 31 October, 1979.
2. The City Engineer is authorized to close the portion of  
the streets herein described at any time during the period  
specified provided the provisions of the Municipal Act,  
R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284, Sec. 352, Par. 60 are complied  
with.
3. The provisions of the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1970, Chapter  
284, Section 352, Paragraph 60 shall apply to the portions  
of the Highways closed by this by-law.
