

BY-LAW NUMBER 776.

By-law number 776, being a by-law to amend by-law No. 771, authorizing the construction of Granolithic Sidewalks on certain streets in the City of North Bay as a Local Improvement under the Provisions of the Local Improvement Act.

WHEREAS G. F. Wield, D. Salmon and others have petitioned the Municipal Council to construct, as a Local Improvement, Granolithic Sidewalks on the north side of Seventh Avenue from Cassells Street to Fraser Street, on the west side of Ferguson Street from Sixth Avenue to Lot #230, approximately 160 feet, and on the west side of Morin Street from Cedar Street to High Street, and the Clerk has certified that the petitions are sufficient and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petitions by amending Schedule "A" of By-law No. 771 passed on the 10th day of August, 1925.

THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS :

(1) THAT Schedule "A" of the said By-law No. 771 authorizing the construction of Granolithic Sidewalks on certain streets in the City of North Bay as set out in said schedule "A", be and is hereby amended by adding thereto the following :

North side of Seventh Ave. from Cassells to Fraser Streets.

West side of Ferguson St. from Sixth Ave. to Lot #230, approximately 160 feet.

West side of Morin Street from Cedar Street to High Street.

Read a second time in Open Council this 5th day of October, 1925.

Rules of Order were suspended and By-law was read a third time short and passed, this 5th day of October, 1925.
