## BY-LAW NO. 1909

## MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS -- BORROWING BY-LAW

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the North Bay (herein called "the Corporation") deems it necessary to borrow the sum of \$400,000.00 to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation for the year;

\*Refer to the estimates for the current year if adopted; if not, to those of last year.

\*AND WHEREAS the total amount of the estimated revenues of the Corporation as set forth in the estimates adopted for the year 1959, not including revenues derivable or derived from the sale of assets, borrowings or issues of debentures or from a surplus including arrears of taxes and proceeds from the sale of assets is \$2,252,170.14;

AND WHEREAS the total amount heretofore authorized to be borrowed this year for the purposes mentioned in subsection (1) of Section 341 of the Municipal Act is \$400,000.00, of which the Corporation has already borrowed a total of \$11:

## THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION hereby enacts as follows:

- 2. All or any sums borrowed pursuant to the authority of this By-law as well as all other sums borrowed in this year and any previous years from the Bank for any or all of the purposes mentioned in the said Section 341 shall, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole or any part or parts of the revenues of the Corporation for the current year and for all preceding years, as and when such revenues are received.
- 3. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all or any sums borrowed as aforesaid, together with interest thereon, all or any of the moneys hereafter collected or received, either on account of or realized in respect of the taxes levied for the current year and preceding years or from any other source, which may lawfully be applied for such purpose.
