THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 54-77

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 1896, BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE TRAFFIC WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay considers it advisable to amend By-law No. 1896 of the Corporation of the City of North Bay;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Subsection (2) of Section 14 (a) of By-law 1896 be amended to provide that it be subject to Subsection (1) so that Subsection (2) shall now read as follows:

(2) Parallel Parking

Subject to Subsection (1), no person shall park a vehicle on any street, other than a one-way street or a street where angle parking is permitted, unless on the right-hand side of the street, having regard for the direction in which the vehicle has been proceeding, and in the event of such parking, the right front and rear wheels of the vehicle shall be parallel to and distant respectively not more than six inches from the edge of the roadway. On uncurbed roads or in the winter, vehicles shall be parked parallel to and as close as circumstances and weather conditions permit to the edge of the boulevard or sidewalk as the case may be."
