

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 96-69

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY AND TO REPEAL CERTAIN BY-LAWS OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY, THE FORMER TOWNSHIP OF WIDDIFIELD, AND THE FORMER TOWNSHIP OF WEST FERRIS, RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION OF THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS.

WHEREAS By-laws Nos. 803 and 1277 of The City of North Bay, By-law No. 1091 of the former Township of Widdifield and By-laws Nos. 384 and 384A of the former Township of West Ferris, all relate to the prohibition of the discharge of firearms within areas defined therein;

AND WHEREAS it is considered advisable to repeal the said by-laws and replace them with this by-law;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of North Bay is empowered by Order of The Ontario Municipal Board to repeal the said By-laws of the former Township of Widdifield and the former Township of West Ferris, and is authorized by statute to repeal By-law No. 803 and By-law No. 1277 of the City of North Bay.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-laws Nos. 803 and 1277 of the City of North Bay, By-law No. 1091 of the former Township of Widdifield, and By-laws Nos. 384 and 384A of the former Township of West Ferris are repealed.
2. No gun or other firearm, airgun or spring gun or any class or type thereof shall be discharged within the limits of the City of North Bay as presently defined and as may be defined from time to time.
3. Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-law shall forfeit and pay, at the discretion of the convicting Judge, a fine or penalty not exceeding the sum of \$300.00 for each offence, exclusive of costs, recoverable under The Summary Convictions Act.
4. This by-law shall not apply to the discharge of guns or other firearms on any firing range under the direction and control of any department or agency of the Government of Canada or of the Government of the Province of Ontario; or to any person, company, club or organization granted permission in writing by the City to carry on range firing, or such other controlled firing activity as shall be designated in such written permission.
5. All other by-laws or parts of By-laws of the City of North Bay, the former Township of Widdifield and the former Township of West Ferris, which conflict with the provisions of this By-law are repealed.
