## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 25-85
BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE AMENDMENT
OF A SUPPLEMENTARY BENEFIT AGREEMENT UNDER
THE ONTARIO MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT
SYSTEM ("SYSTEM")

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 23 of the Regulation made under the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement Systems Act, R.S.O. 1980 as amended, an employer who has elected to participate in the System may enter into or amend an agreement with the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement Board for the payment of supplementary benefits in respect of all or any class of the employees or councillors who are or become members of the System;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of North Bay has entered into a Supplementary Benefit Agreement with the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement Board dated the 20th day of August 1984;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to amend the said Supplementary Benefit Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized on behalf of The Corporation of the City of North Bay to enter into Amending Agreement No. 2 in the form attached hereto with the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement Board.
- 2. The Personnel Officer is hereby authorized to do such things as are necessary and to carry out the intent of the By-law.
- 3. Two certified copies of this By-law shall be filed with the Executive-Director of the Ontario Municipal Employees Retirement Board.
- 4. This By-law shall come into force on the day of its passing.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 18TH DAY OF MARCH 1985.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 18TH DAY OF MARCH 1985.
