

BY-LAW NUMBER 782

BEING a By-law to authorize the construction of sanitary sewers upon certain streets in the City of North Bay as Local Improvements under the provisions of the Local Improvements' Act.

WHEREAS Thos. Sullivan, E. C. Bebee, R. Dodgson, E. J. Labreche, John Jagot, J. T. Sparks, and others have petitioned the Council to construct as local improvements the sewers hereinafter described, and the Clerk has certified that the petition is sufficient and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the petition in the manner hereinafter provided.

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Board of Health has recommended the construction of said sewers as shown on Schedule "A" hereto attached, said approvals being dated August 18th, 1925, November 21st 1925, and November 24th, 1925.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS :

- (1) THAT sanitary sewers be constructed on certain streets in the City of North Bay, as set out in Schedule "A" hereto attached, and which forms a part of this By-law as local improvements under the provisions of the Local Improvements' Act, together with all necessary private drain connections to the line of the Street connecting such sewers.
- (2) THAT the Engineer of the Corporation do forthwith make such plans, profiles and specifications and furnish such information as may be necessary for the making of contract for the execution of the work.
- (3) THAT the work shall be carried on and executed under the superintendence and according to the directions and orders of such Engineer.
- (4) THE Mayor and Clerk are authorized to cause a contract for the construction of the work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or Corporation, subject to the approval of this Council to be declared by resolution.
- (5) THE Treasurer may, subject to the approval of the Council, agree with any bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the work pending the completion of it.
- (6) THE Special assessment shall be paid by 20 equal annual instalments.
- (7) THE Debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the cost of the work when completed shall bear interest at 5% per cent per annum and be made payable within 20 years on the instalment plan.
- (8) ANY person whose lot is specially assessed may commute for a payment in cash the special rated imposed thereon, by paying the portion of the cost of construction assessed upon such lot, without interest, forthwith after the special assessment roll has been certified by the Clerk.


