

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 155-82

BEING A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW 1894 BEING  
A BY-LAW TO REGULATE THE CLOSING OF SHOPS  
BELONGING TO THE CLASS OF HAIRDRESSING PARLOURS.

WHEREAS By-Law 1894 applies only to those hairdressing parlours operating in the old City of North Bay and does not apply to those hairdressing parlours operating in the former Townships of West Ferris and Widdifield, Council deems it desirable to repeal By-law 1894.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law 1894 of the City of North Bay is hereby repealed.
2. That this by-law shall come into force and effect on the date of final passing thereof.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 9TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1982.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 7th DAY OF September 1982.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 7th DAY OF September, 1982.
