BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE ACQUISITION OF AN EASEMENT FOR A WATERCOURSE AND DRAINAGE COURSE.

whereas the municipality is authorized to acquire easements for municipal purposes pursuant to Section 193 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, as amended;

and whereas the Council deems it desirable to acquire easements, for the purpose of maintaining a watercourse adjacent to Doublerinks Park on Commerce Crescent, from The Hydro Electric Commission of North Bay and The Board of Governors of the Canadore College of Applied Arts and Technology;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized to acquire an easement for an above ground watercourse from The Board of Governors of the Canadore College of Applied Arts and Technology, for the sum of of \$2.00 over Part 1 on Registered Plan 36R-8564;
- 2. The Council hereby ratifies and confirms acceptance of the transfer of easement as of December 11, 1990 by way of Instrument No. 306230 in the Land Titles Office for the Registry Division of Nipissing No. 36.
- 3. The Corporation of the City of North Bay is hereby authorized to acquire an easement for an above ground watercourse from The Hydro Electric Commission of North Bay for the sum of \$2.00 over Part 3 on Registered Plan 36R-8564;

4. The Council hereby ratifies and confirms acceptance of the transfer of easement as of February 1, 1991, by way of Instrument No. 307476 in the Land Titles

Office for the Registry Division of Nipissing No. 36.
