BY-LAW NO. 1998

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to authorize the construction of an addition to the Chippewa Secondary School by the North Bay Collegiate Institute and Vocational School Board.

WHEREAS it is expedient to construct and equip an addition to the Chippewa Secondary School consisting of nine (9) classrooms, two (2) commercial rooms, three (3) laboratories, two (2) drafting rooms, six (6) shops, one (1) home economic room, one (1) clothing room, one (1) gymnasium and one (1) cafeteria.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to borrow for the construction of the said addition to the Chippewa Secondary School the sum of \$89,698.00 being the net amount after deducting Federal and Provincial Grants.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. THAT the North Bay Collegiate Institute and Vocational School Board be given authority to construct such new addition of nine (9) classrooms, two (2) commercial rooms, three (3) laboratories, two (2) drafting rooms, six (6) shops, one (1) home economic room, one (1) clothing room, one (1) gymnasium and one (1) cafeteria to the Chippewa Secondary School subject to approval by the North Bay City Council by resolution.
- 2. THAT the North Bay Collegiate Institute and Vocational School Board shall forthwith make such plans and specifications as may be necessary for the calling of tenders, and for the making of a contract for the execution of the work.
- 3. THAT the work shall be carried on and executed under the supervision and according to the direction of the North Bay Collegiate Institute and Vocational School Board, or its architect.
- 4. THAT THE Treasurer of the City of North Bay may, subject to the approval of the Council, agree with any Bank or person for temporary advances of money to meet the cost of construction pending the completion of such construction.
- 5. THAT the debentures to be issued for the loan to be effected to pay for the cost of this work, shall bear interest at such rate as the Council may determine and the debenture principal and the debenture interest be made payable within twenty years on the instalment plan as approved by the Department of Education, and under authority of the Secondary Schools and Boards, of Education Act, being Chapter 362, Section 31, R.S.O. 1960.
- 6. THAT this By-law shall only become effective on the final passing after approval in writing has been secured from The Ontario Municipal Board by virtue of Section 64, Ontario Municipal Board Act, Chapter 274, R.S.O. 1960.
