


- 1. That Section 11 of By-law 1446 be amended by adding thereto Subsection 5, which reads as follows -
 - 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1 a Medical Centre may be constructed on the northerly 99 ft. of Lots 530 and 531 Cassells Street as shown on Registered Plan 21 in the Registry Office for the District of Nipissing, to a maximum height of seventy (70) feet (excluding Penthouse) without setbacks from the Cassells Street and Second Avenue street lines all in accordance with sketches attached hereto as Schedule A.
- 2. That this By-law shall come into effect on the day it is passed by City Council subject to the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.


