BY-LAW NO. 143-83

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE MAIN STREET FROM FERGUSON STREET TO FRASER STREET

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the Downtown Improvement Area Board of Management it is deemed expedient to temporarily close a portion of Main Street pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Sec. 208, Subsection 44.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- That the portion of Main Street from Ferguson Street to Fraser Street in the City of North Bay be and the same is hereby closed from 9:00 o'clock in the forenoon on Saturday the 5th day of November 1983 until 12:00 noon, Saturday, the 5th of November 1983 for the purpose of celebrating the completion of the reconstruction of Main Street.
- 2. That the Director of Planning and Works is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.
- 3. That prior to 1:00 o'clock in the forenoon on the 5th day of November 1983 the Downtown Improvement Area Board of Management will attend to the restoration of the said portion of Main Street to its condition prior to the above closure.
