THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 82-71

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 9-69 PURSUANT TO SECTION 30 OF THE PLANNING ACT, R.S.O. 1960, AND AMENDMENTS THERETO.

WHEREAS upon the request of the property owner concerned and with the approval of the local Planning Board it is considered advisable to amend By-law No. 9-69 to provide for an alteration in the zone designation as shown on Schedule "A" which forms part of said By-law;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- Schedule "A" of By-law No. 9-69 is amended by changing the zoning designation of the land shown outlined in red on the Zoning Map and set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part hereof, from "Rural (RU)" to "Special Zone No. 5-71".
- 2. For the purposes of this By-law, all buildings and structures erected or altered in such "Special Zone No. 5-71" shall conform to the uses and regulations hereinafter set forth:

(a) PERMISSIBLE USES - "SPECIAL ZONE NO. 5-71"

(i) Residential

Single family detached dwelling

(ii) Business

Office use when part of the practitioner's own home Nursing homes and homes for the aged and indigent.

(iii) Recreational

Parks, playgrounds, non-profit making organizations provided that the said use is located in a park or playground.

(iv) Institutional

Private schools other than trade schools, churches, day nurseries licenced under and operated in accordance with The day Nurseries Act, 1966, and regulations made hereunder, in a church hall or in a school building within the terms of The Schools' Administration Act and in a single family detached dwelling where the number of children accommodated at any one time is less than twenty (20).

(v) Public

As set out in 5.8 of By-law 9-69.

(b) REGULATIONS

Within the area outlined in red on said Schedule "A", only buildings, structures and use of land related to nursing homes and homes for the aged and indigent as shown on Schedule "B" attached hereto and forming part hereof shall be permitted.

All other buildings, structures and uses which may be erected or employed on the remainder of said lands shall conform to the R2 Regulations applicable thereto by By-law 9-69.

3. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof, subject to the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.
