

BY-LAW NO. 2135

BEING A BY-LAW to appoint a Board to administer the Community Centre, known as The Community Memorial Building.


WHEREAS in compliance with the Community Centres Act, being Chapter 60, R.S.O. 1960 and regulations thereunder, it is necessary to appoint annually a Board to administer said Community Centre.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT in compliance with Community Centres Act, being Chapter 60, R.S.O. 1960 and the regulations thereunder, and in compliance with Resolution No. 14 of the adjourned Inaugural Meeting held Monday, January 6th 1964, the following named Board were duly appointed for the year 1964.

3. THAT By-law No. 2075 is hereby repealed and all other by-laws inconsistent with this by-law be hereby amended.
4. THAT the said Community Centre shall be maintained as a Community Centre by the said Board in conformity with the Act and regulations made thereunder.
