

BY-LAW NUMBER 777.

BEING a By-law to fix the Polling Places, appoint Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the holding of Municipal Elections for the year 1926.

WHEREAS it is necessary to pass a By-law fixing Polling Places and appointing Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for the purpose of taking the vote of the Electors, to select a Mayor and Nine (9) Aldermen to transact the Municipal affairs of the City; and for the selection of Public School Trustees.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS :

1. That Polling Place No. 1, for the purpose of said election shall be in Mr. W. Santary's Store, No. 384 Main Street West, and A. A. Hansman and A. E. Whittingham are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.
2. That Polling Place No. 2 for the purpose of said elections shall be in the Court House, Bye and McIntyre Streets, and W. E. Jackson and B. Wickett are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.
3. That Polling Place No. 3, for the purpose of said election shall be in Jas. Palangio's Store, No. 38 Front Street, and George Morgan and W. F. Royman are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.
4. That Polling Place No. 4, for the purpose of said election shall be in Hydro Electric Plant, Worthington and Cassells Streets and W. E. Bishop and R. D. Campbell are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.
5. That Polling Place No. 5, for the purpose of said election shall be in the City Hall, McIntyre and Ferguson Streets, and E. H. Bunyan and T. H. Winters are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.
6. That Polling Place No. 6, for the purpose of said election shall be in the G. W. V. A. Club Rooms, McIntyre and Ferguson Streets and Jas. A. Smith and J. E. Lehman are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.
7. That Polling Place No. 7, for the purpose of said election shall be in the Orange Hall, Fisher and McIntyre Streets, and A. E. Laing and R. S. Putnam are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.
8. That Polling Place No. 8, for the purpose of said election shall be in Doan's Store, 234 Main Street E., and G. L. Riches and H. R. Miller are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.
9. That Polling Place No. 9, for the purpose of said election shall be in A. Orfanko's Store, 307 McIntyre Street East, and C. C. Edey and E. R. Herbert are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.
10. That Polling Place No. 10, for the purpose of said election shall be in Mrs. F. Amor's House, 206 Fisher Street, and L. R. Hume and W. C. Colyer are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.

11. That Polling Place No. 11, for the purpose of said election shall be in Orange Hall, Cassells Street, between Third Avenue and Percy Street, and J. J. Pratt E. Lowery are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.

12. That Polling Place No. 12, for the purpose of said election shall be in Chirico's Store, 95 Front Street, and Ed. Everitt and V. B. Willcock are hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officers.

13. That Polling Place No. 13, for the purpose of said election shall be in E. C. Bebee's Store, Cassells and Third Streets and E. C. Bebee is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.

14. That the Railway Employee's Advance Polling Place for the purpose of the said election shall be in the City Hall, Ferguson and McIntyre Streets and A. C. Amos is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer.
