## BY-LAW NUMBER

768. - Perfealed by 79 25 Byland 17/1925 BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-Law Number Six Hundred and Twenty-Five regulating the traffic in the Public streets in the Town of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of North Bay to pass a By-Law amending By-Law Number Six Hundred and Twenty-Five.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NORTH BAY

1. THAT Clause Twenty-One (21) of said By-Law Number Six Hundred and Twenty-Five, is hereby amended by adding after the words "two abreast" the following namely

> "And they shall proceed along the street in a straight line, and as near to the right side of the street as possible, and when making any turn they shall signal direction by holding out their hand, and there shall be no reckless riding or racing, and all bicycles shall carry a bell or horn and at night a lighted lamp, in addition to said bell and horn.

THAT Clause Thirty (30) Ashall be added to said By-Law Number Six Hundred and Twenty-Five, which reads as follows

> "A safety zone line shall be established and laid out on all approaches to Main Street from either sides of said Main Street on Bell, Durrill, Harvey, 10th, Murray Street, Foran Street; Cassells Street; Klock Avenue; Fraser Street; Ferguson Street; Wylde Street; Sherbrooke Street and Fisher Street, Regina and John Streets. All vehicles approaching said safety zone line shall first come to a dead stop before proceeding onto Main Street". as Claure 28

3. THAT Clause Thirty-One (31) shall be added to said By-Law Number Six Hundred and Twenty-Five which reads as follows

> "The following Streets shall be used for parking vehicles only in the manner following, that is to say

Klock Avenue on the East side from Main to Oak Streets.

Klock Avenue on the East side from parking post, north.

Cassells Street, on the West side from Oak Street to Worthington Street.

McIntyre Street on the south side from Cassells Street to Fraser Street.

Fraser Street - on the west side from Oak Street to Worthington Street.

Ferguson Street - on the west side from Oak Street to First Avenue.

Wyld Street - on the East side from Oak Street to First Avenue.

Sherbrooke Street - on west side from Oak Street to Main Street and on the East side only from Main Street to First Avenue.

Oak Street from Ferguson to Wyld on the - North side only.

Save as before provided said By-Law
Number Six Hundred and Twenty-Five (625)
shall remain in full force and effect.

That Clauses 27.28. × 29 shall be sumbared as clauses 29.36 & 32, respectively.
