

A BY-LAW to provide for the payment by the Corporation of the City of North Bay of part of the cost of certain works constructed as local improvements otherwise chargeable upon the lands abutting directly upon the works.

WHEREAS it is expedient that part of the cost of every work of any of the classes or descriptions hereinafter mentioned, constructed as a local improvement which otherwise would be chargeable upon lands abutting directly on the work shall be paid by the Corporation.

AND WHEREAS there is not in force in this Municipality any By-law passed with the assent of the Municipal electors providing that all works of any of the classes or descriptions hereinafter mentioned shall be undertaken as local improvements and not otherwise.

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. The Interpretation section of The Local Improvement Act shall apply to this By-law.

2. That the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) per foot frontage shall be specially assessed upon the lands abutting directly on all sanitary sewers constructed within the limits of the Corporation of the City of North Bay, and that the remainder of the costs of the said sewers shall be borne by the Corporation.

3. This By-law shall apply to such works only as are undertaken after the passing hereof.

Read a first, second and third time and finally PASSED by a vote of three-fourths of all the members of the Council this 21st. day of February A. D. 1927.
