BY-LAW NO. 1463

BEING A BY-LAW of the Corporation of the City of North Bay to provide for establishment of Parks within the said Municipality.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the City of North Bay to set aside certain properties within the Municipality for Park Purposes.

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the following properties presently owned by the said Corporation of the City of North Bay be set aside for Park Purposes, as follows:
 - (a) The North half of Lot 4, all of Lots 5, 6, and 7, on Plan 2W, and Lot 8 on Plan 9W, be set aside to be known as TAYLER'S PARK.
 - (b) All that property known as Lots 124 to 130 on Lawson Street,
 131 to 140 on Reynolds Street, 141 to 150 Vimy Street; and
 151 to 157 on Beatty Street, being known as City Block 158,
 be set aside for Park Purposes.
