

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 63-72

BEING A BY-LAW TO CLOSE AND STOP UP CERTAIN PARTS OF STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS it is considered advisable and in the interest of the Corporation of the City of North Bay that part of Olive Street described in Schedule "A" attached hereto, be closed and stopped up;

AND WHEREAS notice of this By-law was published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the North Bay Nugget, published in the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS no person has claimed that his land will be prejudicially affected by the passing of this By-law and has applied to be heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, by the Council of the said City or a Committee of said Council;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) Upon and after the passing of this By-law, that part of Olive Street described in Schedule "A" and attached hereto and forming part hereof shall be closed and stopped up.
- (2) This By-law shall take effect forthwith upon the passing thereof.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 15TH DAY OF MAY, 1972.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 26TH DAY OF JUNE, 1972.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 26TH DAY OF JUNE, 1972.
