

BY-LAW NO.1353:

BEING A BY-LAW to provide for the Amendment of By-Law No.1330, which is a By-Law for the Licensing and regulation of the use of Pin-Ball Machines and Music Boxes or other such devices operated by the insertion of a coin, within the Municipality of the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS the Municipality of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to amend the aforesaid By-Law.

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Paragraph 2 of By-Law No.1330 be and is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefore:

"2. Every person who owns or keeps for Gain Pin-Ball Machines and Music Boxes or other such Devices whether the same are used or not shall pay a fee of Ten Dollars(\$10.00) for each Music Box and Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each such Pin-Ball or other like machine, up to a limit of Fifty Machines to any one person, but no license shall be issued for any such Machine which yields to the Player thereof Money."
