

BY-LAW NO. 1329

OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

A BY-LAW to provide for the submission of a certain by-Law and question for the assent of the qualified electors of the City of North Bay, and to appoint a day on which to take a vote thereon and to name the places where the votes are to be taken and to appoint Deputy Returning Officers to take the vote at every such place.

WHEREAS the said Council deems it advisable to submit to the vote of the Electors of the Corporation, qualified to vote on proposed Money By-Laws, the proposed money By-Law of the Corporation which is entitled "A By-Law to authorize the purchase of the electrical Distribution System in the City of North Bay and to provide for the borrowing of the sum of Two Hundred and Seventy Five Thousand Dollars for that purpose,

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL of the City of North Bay enacts as follows:-

1. THAT there shall be submitted to the electors of the City of North Bay, qualified to vote on Money By-Laws the proposed by-Law entitled "A By-Law to authorize the purchase of the Electrical Distribution system in the City of North Bay and to provide for the borrowing of the sum of TWO HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$275,000.00) for that purpose", a Copy of which proposed by-Law is hereto attached and Marked as Exhibit "A." and forms part hereof.
2. THAT the votes of the said electors shall be taken on the said question at the following times and places and by the Deputy Returning Officer and Poll Clerks, hereinafter named, that is to say.

THE VOTING SHALL take place on the 7th, day of May A.D. 1940. from Nine O'Clock in the forenoon until Six O'Clock in the afternoon.

ON THE TWENTY-NINTH day of APRIL at his Office in the Council Chamber, on Ferguson Street, in the City of North Bay at 2 O'Clock in the afternoon, the Mayor will in writing signed by him appoint two persons to attend the final summing up of the votes by the Clerk of this Corporation, and one persons to attend each Polling Place on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of promoting the proposed Money-By-Law or voting on the affirmative on the said question, and a like number on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of opposing the proposed Money By-Law or voting in the negative on the said question.

5. THE NINTH DAY OF MAY AT THE SAID COUNCIL CHAMBER AT TWELVE O'Clock in the forenoon is hereby appointed as the time and place for summing up, by the Clerk of this Corporation of the number of votes, given in the affirmative and in the negative, respectively.
