BEING a Bylaw to provide for the taking of the votes of the electors on a proposed Bylaw entitled "A Bylaw to purchase certain property for Park purposes."

WHEREAS a proposed By-law of the Corporation of the City of North Bay entitled "A Bylaw to purchase certain property for Park purposes" requires for its validity the consent of the electors and it is expedient. and necessary to pass this Bylaw for the purpose of enabling the electors to vote on the proposed By-law.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay, enacts as follows:-

The votes of the electors of the Corporation of the City of North Bay shall be taken upon the said proposed Bylaw at the same time and at the same places as the annual election for the lifunicipal Council, and the Deputy Returning Officers appointed to hold said election shall take the vote.

On the 29th day of November, A. D. 1927, at the hour of two $0^{\prime}$ clock in the afternoon, the head of the Council of the said Corporation or some member of the said Council appointed for that purpose by Resolution shall attend at the City Hall, in the said Municipality for the purpose of appointing, and if requested so to do, shall appoint by writing signed by him, two persons to attend at the final summing up of the votes by the clerk, and one person to attend at each polling place on behalf of the persons interested in and promoting the proposed By-law and a like number on behalf of the persons interested in and opposing the proposed Bylaw.

On the fth day of December A. D. 1927, at the hour of ten o'clock in the forenoon, the Clerk. of. the said Municipality shall attend and sum up the votes given for and against the said proposed Bylaw.

Read $\dot{\mathrm{a}}$ first time in Open Council this 8 th day of November, 1927.

Read a second time in Open Council this 8 th day of November, 1927.

Mead a third time short and passed this 8 th day of November, 1927.
