BY-LAW NO. 7-78

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 1097 OF THE FORMER TOWNSHIP OF WIDDIFIELD PURSUANT TO SECTION 35 OF THE PLANNING ACT R.S.O. 1970, CHAPTER 349 AND AMENDMENTS THERETO.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of North Bay deems it advisable to amend By-law No. 1097 of the former Township of Widdifield to designate an officer of the Corporation to be responsible for the administration and enforcement of Zoning By-law No. 1097;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Subsections 2 and 3 of Section 21 PERMITS to Zoning By-law No. 1097 of the former Township of Widdifield is hereby deleted and replaced by the following:
 - "2. This By-law shall be administered by the Director of Planning and Works or such other person as he may designate from time to time.
 - "3. No permit for the use of land or for the erection or use of any building or structure, or approval of any application for any Municipal license within the jurisdiction of Council shall be issued or given where a proposed building, structure or use would be in violation of any of the provisions of this By-law."
- This By-law shall take effect from the date of passing by Council and shall come into force upon the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.
